

Rocky Creek Hut

Rocky Creek Hut is an old stone cottage set within pine and eucalypt plantation. It is suitable for group stays and a great location for day visits.

LOCATION:

From the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre, travel to Meadows then along Battunga Road towards Echungu for 4.3km. Turn Left on to Razorback Road, travel for 2.4km and enter the gate on the left.
GPS: -35°8'44" 138°44'20"

FACILITIES & FEATURES:

- One room cottage, accommodating up to six people on two wooden platforms (bedding not supplied)
- Small food preparation area with sink (crockery, cutlery and cooking equipment not supplied)
- Internal slow combustion wood heater
- Toilet
- Solar lighting inside and out
- Two picnic tables
- Rainwater (not suitable for drinking)
- Fire pit
- Veranda

BOOKINGS:

- Overnight bookings are available between 1 April and 30 November
- A minimum of two nights must be booked between Friday and Sunday
- All organised groups must discuss their activities with the ForestrySA Ranger prior to booking

FEES:

- \$60.00 per day / night (all inclusive)

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

- 12pm arrival, 10am departure
- Please contact the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre one day prior to arrival to obtain access

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE:

- You are not permitted to drive in the forest. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only
- The use of generators is not permitted. Please consider other forest users and keep noise levels down
- Fires: Wood fires are permitted from 1 May to 31 October. Gas fires are permitted from 1 April to 30 November. Dead, fallen timber can be collected from adjoining pine plantations and used for firewood. It is an offence to cut standing timber. Someone must be present at all times and ensure that the fire is fully extinguished before departure
- Cleaning: The hut, toilet and grounds must be left in a clean and tidy state, with all rubbish removed
- Dogs are permitted, provided they are kept under control at all times. Please be aware of fox baiting programs operating in the area
- Other conditions may be imposed by the ForestrySA Ranger
