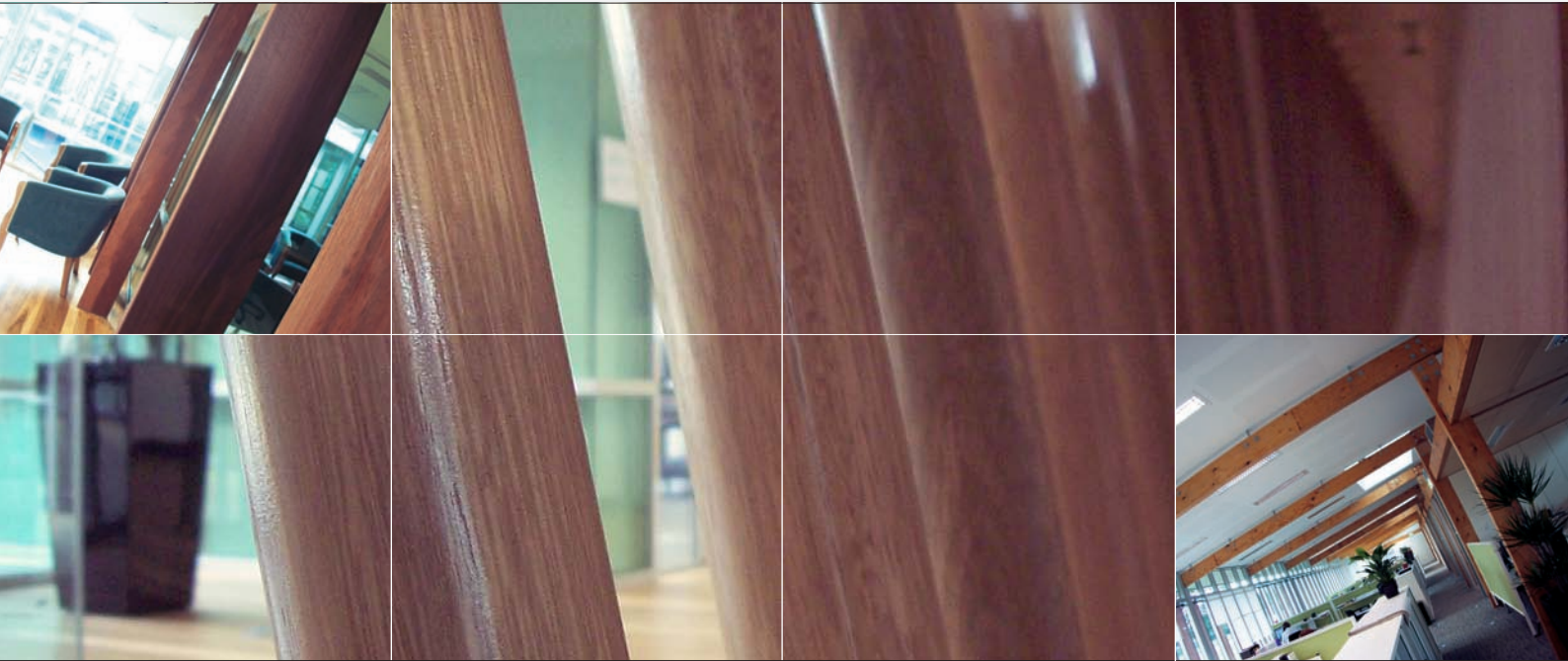


Wood, naturally.
