

Cromer Shed

Cromer Shed is an exclusive-use campground and shelter set within low-lying, open native vegetation. The area is suitable for group stays and events, and provides easy access to nearby walking and bike trails.

LOCATION:

From the Mount Crawford Information Centre turn left onto Warren Road, follow for 2.5km, turn left on to Cricks Mill Road (to Mount Pleasant), follow for 3.5km and turn into Cromer Forest. The campground is located through the gate and to the left. GPS: -34°45'7.5" 138°59'50.9"

FACILITIES & FEATURES:

- Large, three-sided shelter shed
- External picnic tables
- Rainwater (not suitable for drinking)
- Internal and external solar lighting
- Internal fireplace and wood barbecue
- Fire pit
- Toilet

BOOKINGS:

- Overnight bookings are available between 1 April and 30 November.
- A minimum of two nights must be booked between Friday and Sunday
- All organised groups must discuss their activities with the ForestrySA Ranger prior to booking

FEES:

- \$75.00 per night (all inclusive)

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

- 12pm arrival, 10am departure
- Please contact the Mount Crawford Information Centre one day prior to arrival to arrange shed access

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE:

- You are not permitted to drive in the forest. Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only
- The gate to Cromer Shed must be kept locked
- The use of generators is not permitted. Please consider other forest users and keep noise levels down
- Fires: Wood fires are permitted from 1 May to 31 October. Gas fires are permitted from 1 April to 30 November. Dead, fallen timber can be collected from adjoining pine plantations and used for firewood. It is an offence to cut standing timber. Someone must be present at all times and ensure that the fire is fully extinguished before departure
- Dogs are permitted, provided they are kept under control at all times. Please be aware of fox baiting programs operating in the area
- Cleaning: The shed, toilet and grounds must be left in a clean and tidy state, with all rubbish removed
- Other conditions may be imposed by the ForestrySA Ranger
