## FOREST ACCESS PERMIT FEES AND INFORMATION - JULY 2016 For ForestrySA Native Forest and OneFortyOne Plantations lease areas

PERMIT	CONDITIONS	FEE
Caving	Morgans and Snake Hill Caves only. Must be a member of a caving group, where one of the participants is a qualified cave leader. Keys can be collected from the Lady Nelson Visitor and Information Centre, Jubilee Highway East, Mount Gambier	Free
Cave diving	Must be a member of the Cave Divers Association of Australia and book via the association website.	CDAA membership
Horse riding	In plantation areas on tracks only. Prohibited in native forest reserves.	\$50 per adult \$25 per child or concession
Boating	Lake Edward. Entry by permit registration (you will not receive a notification). Restricted to canoes and boats with small electric motors.	Free
Collection of seeds or specimens from Native Forests	This is a restricted permit. You will need to provide evidence of a National Parks and Wildlife Permit, and have prior approval from ForestrySA.	Free
Scientific project / research permit.	Your project will need to be approved. You will need to provide evidence of the sponsoring institution, insurance and fill out the Project Registration Form.	Free
Activities not supported	Camping, fossicking, down-hill mountain bike racing, fires, vehicles in Native Forest Reserves, motor bikes in native forest reserves, vehicles off tracks, unregistered vehicles, shooting, hunting, pets in native forest, taking of plants, animals, soil, objects from forest, firewood and other collection.	-

**For ForestrySA Native Forest and OneFortyOne Plantations lease areas**  
**(Please allow six weeks for processing and approval of all forest event applications)**

EVENT	CONDITIONS	FEE
Motor vehicle event (Basic: Level 1)	<p>Pre-prepared maps attached and emailed to ForestrySA, along with event application and insurance</p> <p>All rubbish removed and site left tidy.</p> <p>*An additional \$500 fee will be incurred if ForestrySA's post-event inspection finds inadequate clean-up has been carried out. In this case, the event organiser would be required to return to the site and carry out further clean-up, at their own expense.</p>	\$600
Motor vehicle event (Basic : Level 2)	<p>As above, but ForestrySA provides access to generic forest maps for assistance with course plotting</p> <p>*An additional \$500 fee will be incurred if ForestrySA's post-event inspection finds inadequate clean-up has been carried out. In this case, the event organiser would be required to return to the site and carry out further clean-up, at their own expense.</p>	\$700
Motor vehicle event (Advanced)	<p>This is for larger events requiring greater coordination</p> <p>Price depends on how much coordination time is required by ForestrySA to manage the event, sponsorship, what materials are provided by ForestrySA and site condition post-event</p>	POA
Caving event (Caves other than Morgans and Snake Hill)	<p>A small number of caves other than ForestrySA's two main recreational caves are available upon application on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>Applicants should clearly state each cave, name, number and location, preferably on a map, and allow six weeks prior to the planned visit for approval.</p> <p>This will allow OneFortyOne Plantations to ascertain whether there are forest operations at each cave at the time of the planned event. If a cave is locked, the key must be picked up from the ForestrySA office strictly during 8am - 5pm Monday to Friday and returned by post within three working days of the event.</p>	\$150
Other events	<p>Other events are available including public and special events, military exercises, orienteering and rogaining. The cost of running an event depends the amount of work involved in processing the application and post event inspections.</p>	POA
