



HELLS HOLE TRAIL

Distance: 750 m loop walk.

Allow: 30 mins for walkers, more for the slower paced.

Terrain: Reasonably flat sandy tracks, with a moderate incline leading up to the sinkhole. Some undulating surfaces. Suitable for walking with sturdy footwear.

Features: After a short walk which meanders through native vegetation, visitors are treated to spectacular views of the sinkhole via a secure observation platform.
