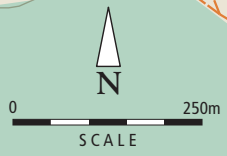




LAKE EDWARD TRAIL
Distance: 2.5 km loop walk.
Allow: 1 hr, more for slower paced walkers.
Terrain: Reasonably flat surfaces that become more obvious during winter months. Sturdy footwear is recommended.
Features: The trail follows the volcanic crater through woodland and open grass plains. There are gradual inclines that provide panoramic views overlooking the lake with a boardwalk leading to a hidden birdhide.
