It also covers the harvesting and delivery of forest products by ForestrySA to customers sourced from the Defined Forest Area. The Defined Forest Area registration applies to the total land under ForestrySA management control in the Mount Lofty Ranges and Green Triangle as documented in the ForestrySA GIS database, excluding the mid north region.

Scope of the audit / review including sites visited	Remote assessment of the systems for managing commercial pine plantations and native forest reserves in the Mount Gambier and Mount Lofty Ranges of South Australia.		
Global-Mark summary of the main findings	A special post-certification review was held to assess the organisation's ongoing conformance with the requirements of AS 4708. Documents were reviewed, systems records were provided, and evidence was gathered to support the audit team's review comments and findings. Audit background: • This post certification audit was originally planned for June 2020, however due to the coronavirus pandemic it was delayed. Field site visits planned for August 2020 were initially postponed until October. • A hybrid audit approach was agreed upon by the organisation and Global-Mark where some system elements would be reviewed remotely and then based on borders re-opening and by following a COVID-19 plan a visit to operational field sites would be conducted by Wayne Tibbits. • New South Australian border closures around the time the field component of the audit was to be conducted (October 2020) meant the field component had to be again postponed. • The Forestry Programme Manager reviewed the remote evidence submitted by the organisation and agreed to update the Post Certification Plan to account for the missed field visits in 2020. • Not all findings from previous audit/s have been reviewed during this remote assessment. • A number of previous audit findings have been partially addressed but remain open pending full implementation to be verified on-site in 2021. Positive comments are as follows: 1. The system is well established, and key elements are able to be reviewed remotely. 2. Staff were approachable, appeared competent in their roles and information was readily provided to the audit team when requested.
