

DIY ORIENTEERING

The carpark for 'The Eucalypts' is 2.4km west along Razorback Road from its T-junction with the Meadows to Echunga Road (which is 4.5 km north of Meadows).

The two courses start in the middle of the purple triangle which is at the noticeboard near the Rocky Creek Hut, 150m SW of the carpark.

In the centre of each purple circle on the course you should find the mapped feature plus a post with a 10x10cm red/white orienteering symbol, the checkpoint number, and a letter code to write in the correct 'control' box below.

The Easy Course should be able to be run / walked in 20 to 45 minutes, and should be possible for 10 year olds who have had a good grounding in the legend symbols, and in holding the map to match the mapped features, or to hold the map at the correct angle to the sun.

It is helpful to fold and to hold the map with your thumb pointing to where you are on it and to the direction of travel.

The Moderate Course should be able to be run / walked in 20 to 60 minutes and a knowledge on how to use an orienteering compass would be very helpful.

The mapped courses are all within gum tree plantations, (except for just north of the start). If you find yourself in pine plantations you are off the map and lost! If lost head north to Razorback Road.

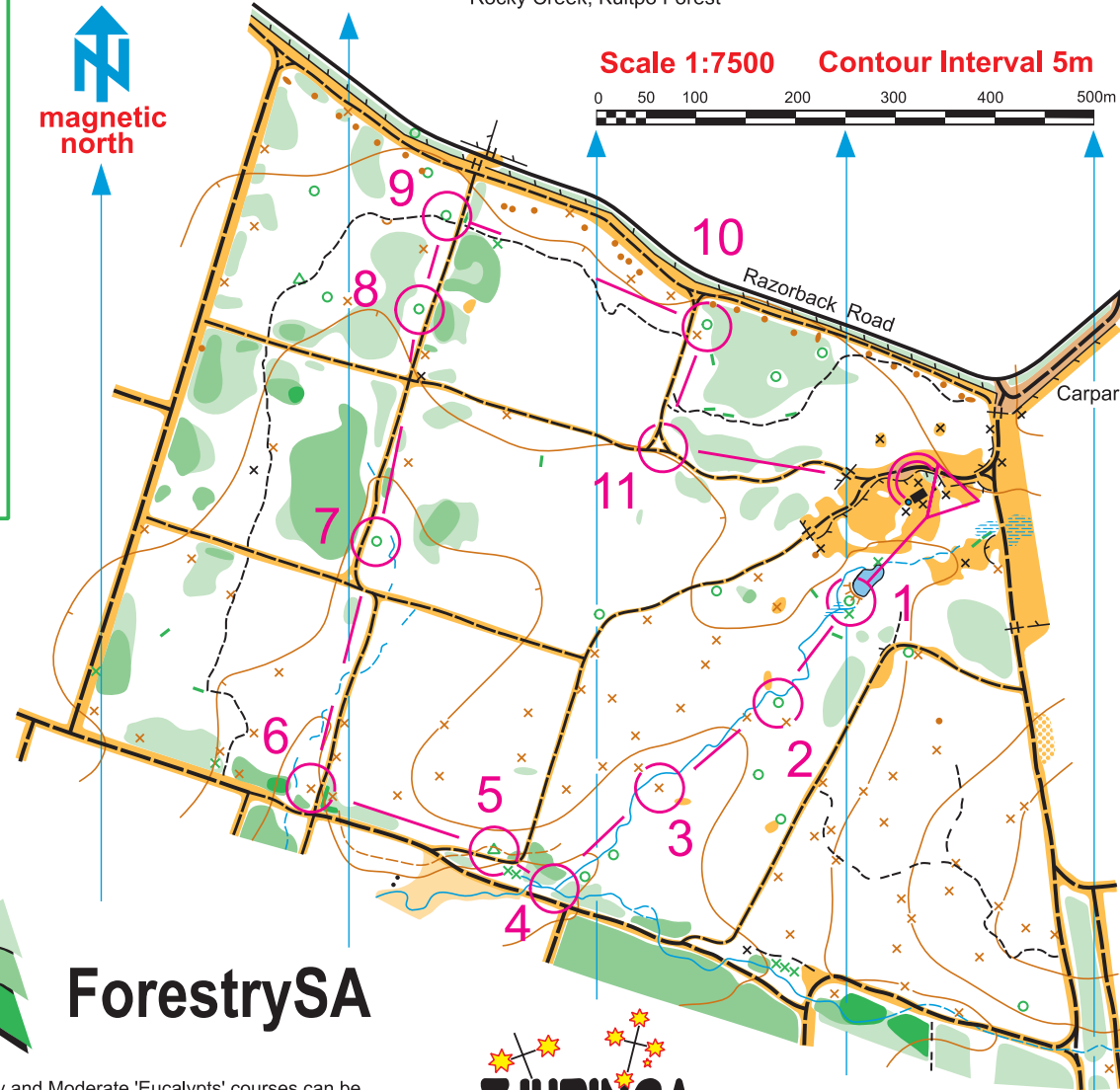

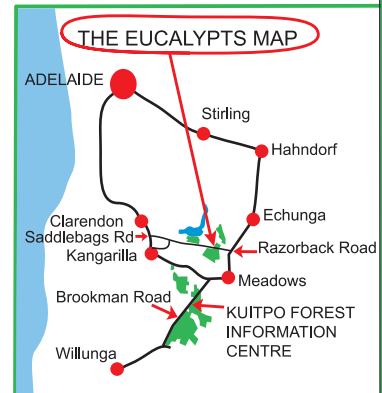
